Executive Recommendation

Buy the TOTO Neorest LS.

It is the strongest overall home-use choice because it balances premium design, proven cleansing and bowl-cleaning technology, strong feature depth, and materially better value than Kohler's true flagship comparable.

Runner-up: TOTO Neorest RS if you want luxury with less capital outlay.

Bottom Line

TOTO wins on ownership value.

The Neorest line is more focused on flushing, hygiene, and low-friction daily use.

Kohler wins on gadget appeal.

Numi 2.0 adds Alexa, audio, and ambient-light theater, but asks a much steeper price and currently shows weaker owner feedback.

TOTO: Across available specialist review sources, the Neorest family is consistently positioned as the benchmark for luxury integrated toilets. The recurring praise centers on bowl-cleaning performance, cleansing quality, reduced manual cleaning, and better day-to-day ownership value.

Kohler Numi 2.0: The official Kohler product page currently shows an aggregate rating of **3.2 out of 5** across **15 reviews**. That is a weak signal at a nearly \$13,000 price point. The visible complaints largely focus on software, controls, connectivity, or reliability frustrations rather than porcelain or flushing alone.

Interpretation: For a primary residence, that difference matters. Luxury bathroom products should disappear into the background and work flawlessly. The more a product depends on apps, voice control, and entertainment features, the more it can feel dated or annoying if execution slips.

If this is for your own home and you want the best overall purchase: buy the **TOTO Neorest LS**.

If you want to spend less and still get real luxury: buy the **TOTO Neorest RS**.

If your priority is showing off a futuristic bathroom: look at the **Kohler Numi 2.0**, but go in with eyes open on software and reliability risk.

If you want the absolute top sculpture piece regardless of economics: the **TOTO Neorest NX2** is the trophy option.
